Buttercup Miniatures - Project for 1:12th Scale seed trays



Materials required

Scissors, glue, tea leaves, cocktail sticks, lolly sticks or thin balsa wood, small pieces of corrugated card cut to 1.5 x 3 cm.

Instructions

A. Seed Tray

- 1. Cut out brown soil.
- 2. Wrap each piece of corrugated card neatly with soil, making sure the join is underneath. Glue wrapping in place.
- 3. Cut pieces of lolly stick so they fit around the edges of the tray (as shown above), the tray should be slightly taller than the soil. Glue to sides of soil. Allow to dry.
- 4. Cut two pieces of lolly stick to fit lengthwise on the underside of the seed tray. Glue in place and leave to dry.
- 5. Cover the top surface of the seed tray with glue, sprinkle on some tea leaves and leave to dry. Once dry shake off excess tea leaves.
- 6. Optional Cut out two sheets of newspaper and glue under the seed tray as shown above, add a couple of dabs of glue onto the top of the paper and sprinkle with tea leaves. Leave to dry, once dry shake off excess tea leaves.

B. Seed packets

- 1. Cut out seed packets, fold and glue them together, including top tab. Leave to dry.
- 2. Tear base off some seed packets and insert a small piece of cocktail stick, as shown above. Glue in place. Leave to dry.
- 3. When the seed packet is well stuck to the stick insert the stick at one end of the seed tray as shown above.
- 4. Partly tear the tops off other seed packets and glue to the newspaper under the seed trays or scatter these about by the seed trays.
