

Additional requirements: scissors, paper glue

Cover

- 1. Cut around edges of strip (for 1:6th scale cut around both strips, making sure you also include the white flap at right hand side of upper strip. **For 1:6th scale only -** glue flap on inside 1 behind left hand side of inside 2. Leave to dry.
- 2. Fold along page edges marked with arrows, so that printed sides are on the outer sides (hill folds), then fold along the lines marked with a single | so that the printed sides are together (valley fold). Your strip of paper should now be a concertina shape.
- 3. Glue backs of pages together, so that the inside sheet forms a book the two blank end pages should not be stuck to anything. Leave to dry.
- 4. Cut out cover. Glue back of cover and backs of blank pages on outside of book, run a line of glue along the spine of the book. Carefully stick front of cover to the book to the back of the blank page at the front of book, wrap around spine and stick to back page of book. Run the scissors down the spine of the book to give definition to the spine. Leave to dry.
- 5. Trim sides of book if required.

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
