

## Buttercup Miniatures - Project for 1:12<sup>th</sup> and 1:6<sup>th</sup> Scale Cake Boxes



Please note boxes shown above are 1:12<sup>th</sup> scale

### Extra materials required:

Scissors or craft knife, cardboard, and paper glue.

### Instructions

1. Print out boxes and stick onto thin card (such as a cereal packet, stick paper onto coloured side of cereal box)
2. Carefully cut around boxes making sure that all tabs are cut out.
3. Gently score along black lines to make folding easier.
4. Cut along black lines at short sides of tabs, so these can be folded inwards.
5. Stick white tab at side of box behind front panel and leave to dry. Fold smaller tabs in at base and then stick large white tab to these, leave to dry, then stick base of box to white tab, leave to dry
6. Fold in two remaining tabs and then tuck flap of box lid into box.
