
Buttercup Miniatures - 1: 6th and 1:12th scale notelets and box project

Additional requirements: cocktail stick, thin ribbon, scissors, glue, ruler and thin card (see Note below)

Note: Before starting project cut out box lid and base and glue on thin card (such as a cereal box, glue on printed side of cardboard, so the inside of the finished box does not show printed cereal box)

Read through ALL instructions before commencing project.



Box Top

- 1. Cut out around coloured lid and white corners, then cut flaps down to blue edge along red lines marked by arrows.
- 2. Score lightly along black lines so that the box lid folds easily.
- 3. Fold box lid into shape by folding white corner tabs under the end flaps.
- 4. Place a spot of glue on each white tab and stick in place under the end flaps.
- 5. Leave to dry completely, making sure the tabs do not come unstuck.

Box base


- 1. Cut out box base, then cut along lines for end flaps as shown on box lid above.
- 2. Score lightly along black lines so that the box lid folds easily.
- 3. Fold box base into shape by folding grey corner tabs under the end flaps.
- 4. Place a spot of glue on each grey tab and stick in place under the end flaps.
- 5. Leave to dry completely, making sure the tabs do not come unstuck.

Notelets



- 1. Cut around notelet just inside grey lines.
- 2. Fold in half along black dotted line as shown in picture above stage 1.
- 3. Then fold notelet in half again along red dotted line as shown in picture in step 2.
- 4. Repeat process until all six notelets are made.

Envelopes



- 1. Cut around envelope just inside black lines.
- 2. Fold sides of envelope in along lines marked by red lines in picture.
- 3. Fold up base of envelope along line marked in green.
- 4. Run a very thin line of glue along underneath EDGE of envelope flap from A to B as shown above and then from B to C.
- 5. Press lower flap of envelope onto the side flaps and stick down.
- 6. Insert cocktail stick into envelope and move it around gently to ensure the flaps of the envelope do not stick to the front of the envelope. This may need to be repeated if you have to press down flaps again to ensure they stick.
- 7. Leave to dry completely.
- 8. Fold down top flap of envelope, but DO NOT stick down


Assembly


- 1. Take 3 envelopes and place in a pile, making sure all the flaps are facing to the bottom of the pile.
- 2. Place 3 notelets of the same design face up on the pile of envelopes.
- 3. Cut ribbon and tie around the pile of notelets as shown below (you do not need to tie a bow, as a knot will look just as good):



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- 4. Trim ends of ribbon.
- 5. Repeat steps 1-4 above with remaining notelets.
- 6. To make divider take a piece of thick paper or card and fold as shown below, centre piece should be approx 1/8th-inch/0.3 cm wide for 1;12th scale and ¼-inch/0.6 cm wide for 1:6th scale, and the fold in the centre should not be taller than the box it is to go in:






- 7. Place the divider inside the box base (you do not need to stick this to the box base, but can if you wish) and then place notelets inside box as shown.
- 8. Place lid on box.
